12. Affiliations, to ARC / EA Registrations and race permits

ARC affiliation and event permitting through them continues. In 2012/2013 we had 54 members opting to pay the EA affiliations of £5.00. In 2013 to 2014 we had 16 members opting to pay the EA affiliations of £10.00. In 2014 to 2015 we had 29 members opting to pay the EA affiliation of £10.00. In 2015 to 2016 we had 22 members opting to pay the EA affiliation of £12.00 (discounted to £10 by the club). In 2016 to 2017 we had 29 members opting to pay EA affiliation of £13.00 (discounted £10 by the club)

The EA fees are going up again. The club will be paying $\pounds 100$ (the same) and each individual will be asked to pay $\pounds 14$ up another $\pounds 1$).

Officially you need to do this to qualify to enter EA permitted events as an affiliated runners (usually saving £2 per race but in 2016 onwards will be £3). Events are supposed to ask for your EA registration number on entry forms and check online. Members are reminded that both Club and EA membership/ EA affiliations will become due again on or before the 1^{st} April 2016

You can enter ARC organised events without paying this extra fee or providing an EA Registration number.

The suggestion at the last committee is to discontinue subsidising the extra for EA affiliation.
